La Lumiere School Hosts First Annual Laker Business Lunch at the Union League Club of Chicago

November 2010 – ULCC member Ned Costello, Senior Vice President, U.S. Trust, Bank of America, hosted a group of La Lumiere School students and alumni at the first annual **Laker Business Lunch**. Featured speakers included ULCC member Joe Gaffigan from the La Lumiere class of '81 and Bill Igoe from the class of '74. Gaffigan, President and CEO of MFC Capital Funding, Inc. shared with the students how his company was designed to respond to an under-served niche in the capital funding market. Igoe shared with the group how his experience as a manager of derivative research and systems design led to the founding of Bachelier Capital. After the formal presentations, the conversation turned to the current economy and the recent announcement by the FOMC to purchase bonds in a move known as “quantitative easing.” The students, who have been studying the FOMC and the effect of monetary policy on the economy, found the ensuing conversation illuminating.
