La Lumiere Students Sponsor Improv Night to Benefit Nicaraguan Youth

La Porte, Ind. – November 8, 2010 – On Friday, November 12, a group of La Lumiere students will host an Improv Night featuring *Scene Ends in Death* to benefit the Fabretto Children's Foundation whose mission is to enable impoverished Nicaraguan children and their families to break the cycle of poverty and reach their full potential through programs promoting education, nutrition, health, and community development.

The performance will take place on the La Lumiere Campus. A fee of \$5 will be charged for entry and all proceeds from the benefit will be donated to the Fabretto Children's Foundation to underwrite the cost of educating a child. A donation of \$360 a year will enable a primary or secondary school child to go to school, stay in school and succeed in school by ensuring that he or she has enough food to eat, school uniforms and supplies, and access to half day after-school activities, including tutoring, mentoring, study hall, sports, arts, music, life skills training, and job skills training.

Each year for the past 4 years, students from La Lumiere School have traveled to Nicaragua during their spring break to work with the Fabretto Children's Foundation. The students are passionate about this cause and invite the public to join them in their effort to raise funds for the Fabretto Children's Foundation. Tickets will be sold at the door.
