La Lumiere Announces Honor Roll Students

January 20, 2010 La Porte, Ind. – La Lumiere School announces its honor roll for the second quarter. 123 students of a total student body of 209 reached a status of excellence: 35 Summa Cum Laude, 50 Magna Cum Laude, and 38 Cum Laude. Representation from the classes includes 27 freshmen, 39 sophomores, 28 juniors and 29 seniors. Two students achieved a perfect grade point, receiving an A-plus in every subject. Academic Dean, Kevin Spingler commented on the rarity of such an achievement, “In light of the challenging academic workload and the other demands of our students’ time and energy, it is a rare achievement for a student to attain perfection by getting A-pluses in all of their courses. In the previous five years we have only had one student do it for a marking period, and this year we have had two students achieve this level of success in the same marking period.”

The La Lumiere Honor Roll is based on a 4.0 scale. Cum Laude students are those with a cumulative un-weighted grade point average of 3.0 or higher with no grade lower than a “C”. Magna Cum Laude students are those with an un-weighted 3.5 grade point average or higher and no grade lower than a “C”. Summa Cum Laude students are those with a cumulative, un-weighted grade point of 4.0 or higher.
