La Lumiere Lakers Place 2nd in National Basketball Tournament

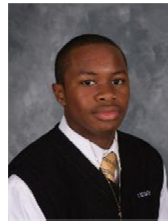

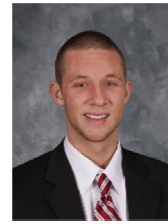
