American Red Cross Blood Drive Hosted by the La Lumiere School Chapter of SADD (Students Against Destructive Decisions)

La Porte, Ind. – February 28, 2010 – The La Lumiere School chapter of SADD will hold its seventh annual community blood drive, Wednesday, March 23 from 12:00 – 4:00 p.m. in the Fine Arts Building on campus. SADD students are inviting community donors to “come and roll up their sleeves” in order to save lives and give back to the community. While Red Cross professionals will manage all aspects of the blood drive, SADD students will assist with refreshments and moral support. Every two seconds someone in the United States needs blood, but only 5% of the eligible US population donates blood in any given year, according to the American Red Cross. Healthy donors are the only source of blood, and currently there is no substitute. Blood is needed for emergencies and for people who have cancer, blood disorders, sickle cell, anemia and other illnesses.

The American Red Cross of La Porte County provides health and safety education, disaster response and prevention services, blood procurement, military communication, veteran aid, and youth programs.

The Mission of SADD is to provide students with the best prevention and intervention tools possible to deal with the issues of underage drinking, other drug use, impaired driving and other destructive decisions.
