La Lumiere Announces Honor Roll Students

January 4, 2012 La Porte, Ind. – La Lumiere School announces its honor roll for the second quarter. 141 students reached a status of excellence: 37 Summa Cum Laude, 60 Magna Cum Laude, and 44 Cum Laude. Representation from the classes include; 28 freshmen, 34 sophomores, 42 juniors and 37 seniors. Headmaster Michael Kennedy commented, “I find this impressive for several reasons: we strive to improve our program every year and we have raised the bar in the form of expectations and rigor – and yet the students continue to rise to the occasion. We can document that our kids are well-prepared for college, and colleges certainly know that La Lumiere challenges students academically. One indicator is our students’ early acceptances to University of Notre Dame, Northwestern University, University of Chicago, and Indiana University, just to name a few.”

The La Lumiere Honor Roll is based on a 4.0 scale. Cum Laude students are those with a cumulative un-weighted grade point average of 3.0 or higher with no grade lower than a “C”. Magna Cum Laude students are those with an un-weighted 3.5 grade point average or higher and no grade lower than a “C”. Summa Cum Laude students are those with a cumulative, un-weighted grade point of 4.0 or higher.
