La Lu Parent Ambassador Program

The Parent Ambassador Program helps new families integrate into the La Lumiere community by making matches with current family volunteers. There are many things that make La Lu exceptional, but it is our close-knit community that truly sets us apart from so many other schools, and it is why many families ultimately decide to send their children here. This culture is sustained through our dedicated faculty and staff but also through our amazing parent involvement. Navigating a new school can be challenging and most families begin with several questions. This is where the Parent Ambassador Program steps in. The Ambassadors are meant to bridge the gap between the school and the family, by serving as a point of contact to address any questions and guide new families to make an easy transition into the La Lu community.

What it Means to be a Parent Ambassador

The expectation for the Parent Ambassador Volunteer is to be a welcoming presence for new families and to reach out to families at least three times before the beginning of the school year. The Ambassador Program will provide further reminder emails for the volunteers for when the contacts should take place, and even some suggested email templates to use on how to best check-in with their assigned families. The hope is that Ambassadors will be able to meet their assigned families in person on Opening Day in August and even build a lasting relationship.
