Job Summary: The La Lumiere School girls varsity golf coach oversees all aspects of the school's girls golf program. The coach will be responsible for developing and implementing a successful golf program while ensuring the safety and well-being of all team members. The head coach must have strong leadership skills, motivate players, and work collaboratively with school administration and other coaches. The La Lumiere School girls golf coach plays a vital role in shaping student-athletes futures. The ideal candidate should be committed to the development of student-athletes both on and off the field.

Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities:

- Establish and communicate the fundamental philosophy, skills, and techniques to be taught by coaches at all program levels
- Develop and implement practice and game plans
- Design practice schedules and drills that improve players' skills, fitness, and teamwork
- Comply with all aspects of the coaching handbook & La Lumiere by-laws and policies
- Monitor the safety conditions of the facility or area in which assigned sport is conducted at all times that athletes are present
- Clearly communicate with individual/team about goals, performance, and progress
- Develop and maintain a competitive environment
- Assist with hiring and direct, and supervise assistant coaches
- Maintain accurate statistics, records, and results of the season
- Instruct individual participants in the skills necessary for excellent achievement in the sport involved
- Enforce discipline and sportsmanship behavior at all times, and establish and oversee penalties for breach of such standards by individual athletes
- Develop a strong rapport with students and provide mentorship and guidance as needed.
- Encourage players to maintain academic success
- Maintain competency in rules, rule interpretations, game procedures, coaching techniques, and general information about all aspects of the sport
- Comply with pre-season, in-season, and post-season expectations set forth by the athletic director and what is outlined in the coaches' handbook
- Work with the athletic director to manage the budget for the golf program; recommend purchase of equipment, supplies, and uniforms and submit in a timely manner
- Account for all equipment during the preseason, in-season, and postseason
- Maintain required attendance forms for practices, games, and special team events
- Exhibit acceptable personal conduct and appearance before, during, and after games
- Work collaboratively with other coaches and athletic staff to coordinate practice and game schedules and to ensure that all sports programs are aligned with the school's goals and values.
