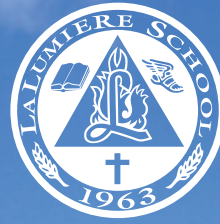

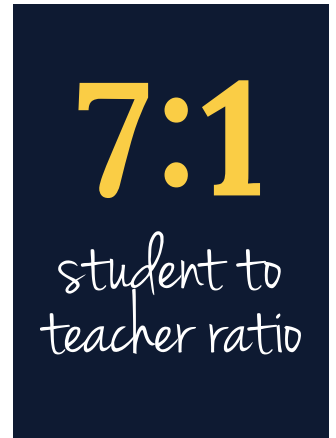

ACADEMICS

The core of our mission is to nurture and develop the whole person in an academically challenging environment that promotes active engagement and personal responsibility.

Our liberal arts curriculum provides a foundation in English literature and composition, mathematics, history and social sciences, physical and life sciences, world languages, theology, ethics, and the creative arts, with a special emphasis on critical thinking and the mastery of oral and written communication.

Our academic program provides La Lumiere graduates with a distinct advantage over most of their peers: they are trained to think critically, articulate clearly, and take action confidently—grounded in a keen awareness of morals and values.

STUDENT LIFE

La Lumiere believes in educating the whole student. The character traits and abilities that make for a good life cannot be developed in an academic program alone. They come also from skills and habits instilled outside the classroom. That is why co-curricular activities are a crucial, required dimension of La Lumiere School. They enhance each student's education, strengthen relationships with teachers, and deepen the community bond.

The Arts

Co-curricular arts opportunities are diverse, and generally include theater performances (with opportunities to produce original work), music performances, film festivals, and Fine Arts Wednesdays—a community-wide arts sharing experience.

Clubs & Activities

Student-led club offerings vary year-to-year, but some commonly recurring and popular opportunities include Chess Club, Film Club, Fishing Club, Spike Ball Club, and Black Student Union.

Athletics

Sports play an integral role in the formation of character for La Lumiere students. There are 15 varsity sports across three seasons. Athletic opportunities include baseball, basketball, cheer, cross country, golf, lacrosse, soccer, tennis, and volleyball.

Community Service

La Lumiere believes that selfless giving and understanding the needs of one's broader community are integral parts of character formation. We aim to cultivate among our students a willingness and desire to serve. Students regularly serve at Big Brothers Big Sisters, the Humane Society, local nursing homes, and local public elementary schools.
